

UNION COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

Meeting Minutes

April 8, 2021

Chairman, Kyle Richardson, called the regular monthly meeting to order at 2:00pm. Mr. Richardson as well as Rick Walker, Rodney Malone, Jeff Collins, Deborah Viles and Candy Booker-Tindell were in attendance. Jack Effler was absent.

Mr. Walker made a motion to approve the minutes from the March meeting, seconded by Mr. Malone. The motion was passed with all commissioners voting aye.

Thirty-nine new voter registration applications were presented for review. After examination of the applications by the attending commissioners, Mr. Malone made the motion to approve the applications submitted. The motion passed with a second from Mr. Collins and all commissioners voting aye.

Next on the agenda was the ballot for the upcoming City of Luttrell election. After reviewing the petitions turned in by mayoral candidate, Jerry Lawson and city council candidate, Caleb Dykes and a brief discussion concerning write in candidates, the ballot was approved. Mr. Walker made the motion to approve the ballot with a second by Mr. Malone. All commissioners voted aye.

After discussion on the location for Luttrell City early voting, Mr. Walker suggested that early voting be held at the Paulette building as it was with the November 2020 election. Mrs. Viles called to reserve the building for early voting dates, it was not available. The Luttrell Community Building was suggested; however, it is booked during early voting days. He then suggested the court room at Luttrell City Hall. Mrs. Viles contacted Mayor Jerry Lawson to check availability. Mayor Lawson said it was available. Kelly Dyer Mink, Allison Smith, Jim Black and Mary Merritt were approved to hold early voting with Smith being the officer. Mr. Collins then made a motion to approve both the location and the poll workers for early voting for the City of Luttrell election and to appoint the same workers for election day June 3. Mr. Walker second the motion. It was passed with all commissioners voting aye.

Mrs. Viles reminded the commissioners that their reappointment packets from the state should be arriving in the mail this week and must be returned by April 26.

A school of instruction for poll workers will be held Tuesday May 10 at 2:00pm.

The motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Walker and seconded by Mr. Collins. Chairman Richardson adjourned the meeting. The next regular meeting of the Union County Election Commission will be held Thursday, May 13 at 2:00pm.
