- FEBRUARY 2, 2026 - 1ST DAY TO PICK-UP QUALIFYING PETITION FOR OFFICE
- APRIL 2, 2026 - NOON -CANDIDATE QUALIFYING PETITION DEADLINE
- APRIL 9, 2026 - NOON – CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE
- MAY 8, 2026 – 1ST DAY TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT
- JULY 7, 2026 – LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE
- JULY 17, 2026 – EARLY VOTING BEGINS
- JULY 27, 2026 – LAST DAY TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT
- AUGUST 1, 2026 – LAST DAY OF EARLY VOTING
